

## Settings

Under **Settings**, you should see your mobile phone number and the **Default calling method** should be set to **Mobile phone** in order to access your mobile phone's voice network.

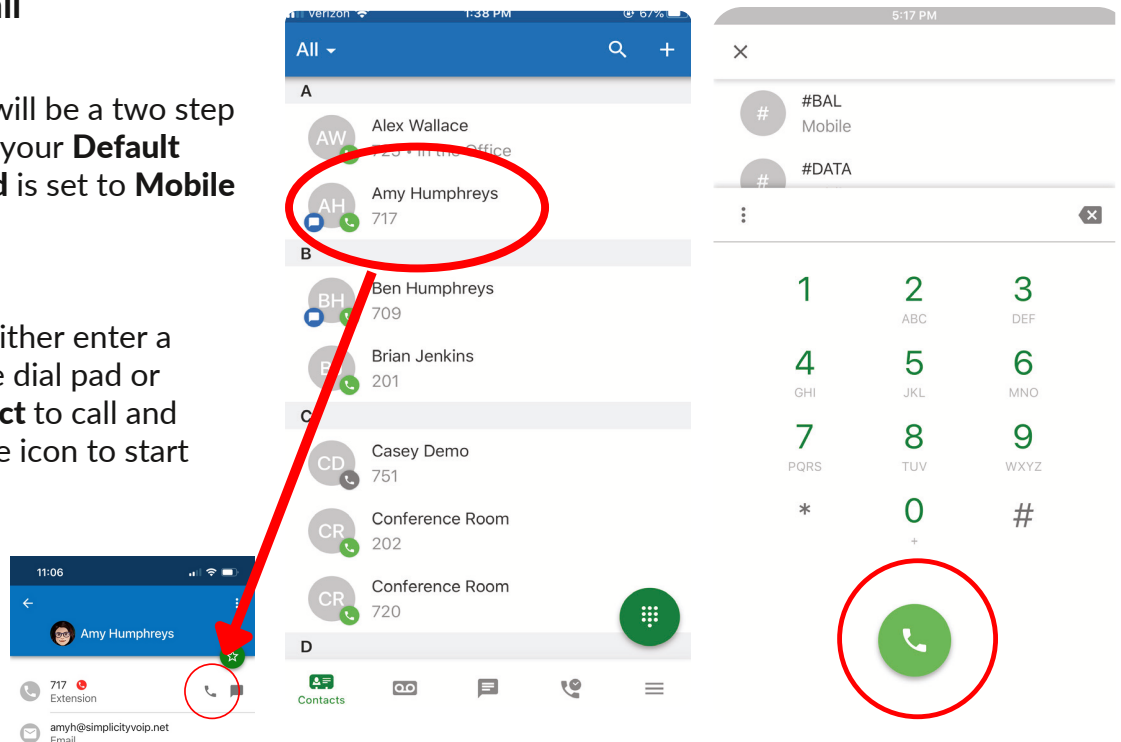
*Note: Using your mobile phone as your default calling method will allow you access to whatever quality your current mobile voice network is experiencing.*

## Making a Call

Making a call will be a two step process when your **Default calling method** is set to **Mobile phone**

### STEP 1 -

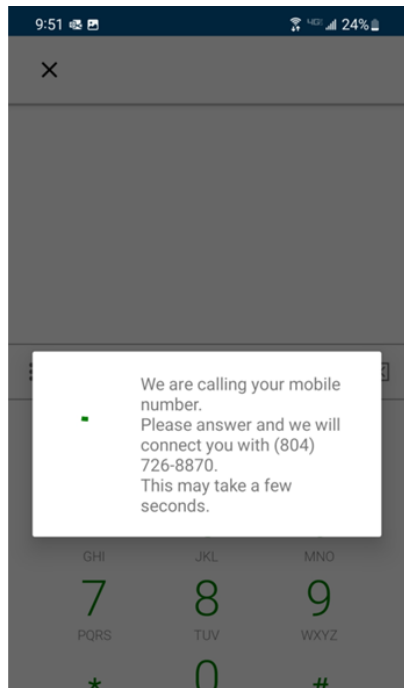
You will first either enter a number on the dial pad or select a **Contact** to call and click the phone icon to start the call.



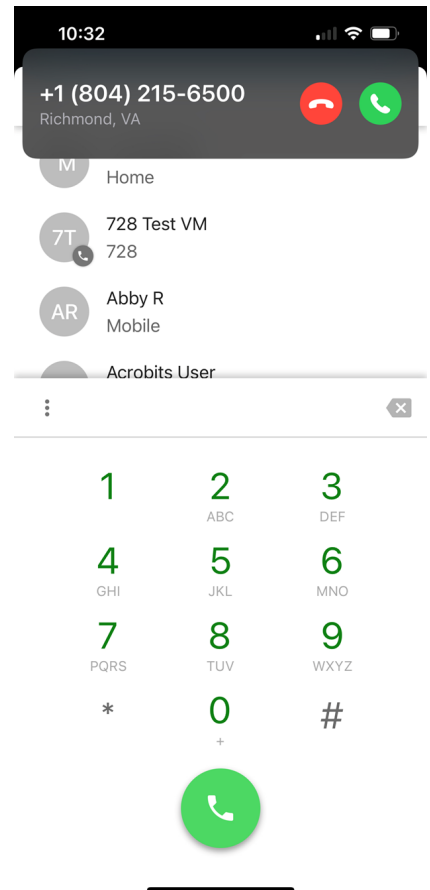
**STEP 2 -**

When your **Default calling method** is **Mobile phone**, the **SimplicityGo** app will first call you in order to connect to your voice network. You will answer this call, which will then start ringing the **Contact** you are trying to reach.

*Note: Your mobile phone number will not be shown to the contact you are calling, only the number associated with your **SimplicityGo** app.*



*Android will display the number you are dialing*



*iOS will not display the number you are dialing*
